



Search – School Districts




Example: Find schools with the name "Benton"



- 1. Choose School Search
- 2. Choose "Name"
- 3. Begin typing "Benton". The list of schools displayed will shrink as letters are typed.
- 4. You can click the search button to search for schools with "Benton" in the name or click on a school in the list to search for just that school.

LEA numbers are also acceptable. If a number is typed, the list will display LEAs which start with the number typed.

Example: Find schools in the city of Benton



- 1. Choose School Search
- 2. Choose "City"
- 3. Begin typing "Benton". The list of cities displayed will shrink as letters are typed.
- 4. A city must be chosen from the list to search for schools in that city.

Schools located less than 25 miles from the entered zip code

County















- Once logged in, a shortcut link to a user's school district and/or assigned schools appears









(Teacher, has link to view school)
